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Electroluminescent Lamp Driver IC for LCD Displays in Portable Products



Introduction

The MC33441 Electroluminescent Lamp (EL) Driver IC is a DC-AC inverter IC for driving EL lamps in low power portable products. The device can operate from as low as 1.8 V to 3.5 V DC input voltage and is capable of supplying 140 Vp-p typical AC output voltage. The special design features an extremely low standby current of 10 nA which is ideal for products such as pagers, cellular phones, calculators, databanks, portable CDs and portable minidisks. There is a built in coil drive current limit of 70 mA that protects the coil from saturation. The device also features an H-bridge configuration which increases the life of the EL Lamp by maintaining a low bias drive of only 2 V.

The MC33441 requires fewer external components in the system design, except for an inductor and a resistor, to generate the desired AC output voltage and fine tune the oscillator. The device is available in an 8-pin TSSOP surface mount package.


